A LifeBook is a record of an adoptee's life that uses words, photos, graphics, the child's artwork, and memorabilia. A LifeBook always starts at the child's birth. A LifeBook is more than a life story. It is a unique opportunity for parents to honour every minute of their children's lives. It is the single most meaningful piece of "paperwork" that any parent can complete. A LifeBook is not a scrapbook. A Lifebook captures and records the information your child needs about his or her life.

- ♦ Hear Beth share her personal journey from foster care to adoption to adulthood.
